<u>Fox Mill Woods Fintastics vs. Poplar Tree</u> <u>Pirates – June 23, 2001</u>

The opening meet of the 2001 summer swim season was against the always-tough Poplar Tree Pirates. A meeting between the two swim powers in 2000 went down to the final relay race as the Pirates puled out a narrow victory. Could

the Fintastics return the favor at the Poplar Tree home pool?

The weather, a damp and drizzly 62°, seemed perfect for cool-water fishy Fintastics, but the Pirates quickly jumped out to a 53-37 lead in freestyle.

Stroking up points for Fox Mill Woods, first place finishers included Kristen Callahan, Kirsten Siebach, Scott Hubal and Lindsay Ward. Second place honors went to Edward Reed, Katie Callahan, Amanda Hubal, Tommy Huycke and Jennifer Dolson. Third placers included Leanne Hyer and William Byrne.

The Pirates continued to pull away in the back event, leading 110-70. Finishing in first place for Fox Mill Woods were Leanne Hyer, Michael Hallock, Erica Demson and Sascha Reed. Gathering second place points were Matthew Montgomery, Hannah Cohen and Allison Kendrick. Third placers included Alison Jarmas, Suzanne Huycke, Zachary Kearns and Kelly Sherman.

Our lady breaststrokers continued their tradition of first-place dominance by winning every heat. First place honors went to **Kristen Callahan**, **Katie Callahan**, **Kirsten Siebach**, **Hannah Cohen** and **Jennifer Callahan**. Second place finishers in the breaststroke included **Michael Hallock**, **Matthew Montgomery** and **Jennifer Dolson**. Third place finishers were **Liam McLaughlin**, **Christopher Kearns** and **Brian Pujanauski**.

In the fly, the Fintastics created strong momentum by winning five of eight events. First place finishers were Sascha Reed, Scott Hubal, Amanda Hubal, Tommy Huycke and Allison Kendrick. Finishing second was William Byrne. Third place finishers included Edward Reed, Erica Demson, Ana Demson, Zachary Kearns, Kelly Sherman and Austin Hyland.

Going into the relays, Poplar Tree held a commanding 195-146 lead.

In the 8 and under 100 meter relay, the girls team of **Leanne Hyer, Stephanie Hallock, Alison Jarmas** and **Kristen Callahan** easily won with a time of 1:33.66. After dropping the next three events, the Fintastics ripped off three straight winning heats.

The 11-12 girls medley relay team of **Kirsten Siebach**, **Ana Demson**, **Suzanne Huycke** and **Sascha Reed** edged out the Pirates with a time of 1:12.26. The 13-14 boys medley relay team of **Matthew Montgomery**, **Zachary Kearns**, **Ben Coffinberger** and **Scott Hubal** also powered to victory with a time of 1:13.03. On the girls' side, the team of **Hannah Cohen**, **Amanda Hubal**, **Lindsay Ward** and **Kelly Sherman** easily bested the Pirates with a 1:08.92 time.

Rounding out a strong relays finish, the Fintastics won both mixed 200-meter freestyle relays, the winning boys included **Scott Hubal**, **Michael Hallock**, **Matthew Montgomery** and **Tommy Huycke**, swimming a 2:03.98. The winning girls included **Sascha Reed**, **Katie Callahan**, **Lindsay Ward** and **Allison Kendrick**, who delivered a 2:17.98.

With the teams splitting the relays at six wins each, Poplar Tree cruised to a comfortable win.

Coach Shelley said, "Our opening meet was very exciting and I was proud that our team fought hard right down to the last two winning relay events. We have a young team and a lot of potential for a great winning summer season. Let's practice hard this week to ensure a win this coming Saturday."

The following are some highlights of our swimmers' achievements:

Freestyle

In the boys 6 and under, J.T. Byrne finished sixth with a time of 39.99. FMW had a strong showing in the 7-8 event with three swimmers, Dan Traxler, Andy Putch and Patrick Cary placing fourth, fifth and sixth, respectively. Bobby Demson brought home a first place finish with a time of 47:04 in the 9 year old The ten year old heats were another event. success story for FMW, with Jack Brennan placing second, Liam McLaughlin coming in third and John Suyama finishing fourth. Kevin Pujanauski secured a sixth place finish in the 11-12s. Matt Montgomery and Steven Matthews contributed with fourth and fifth place finishes in the 13-14 event. Strong swimming yielded a fourth place finish for Mike Leeds and a fifth place for Joey Coffinberger in the 15-18. Good job, boys!

FMW had a superb showing in the girls 6 and under freestyle, walking away with first (Stephanie Hallock) and second (Chloe Seibach) places! In the girls 7-8 heats, Allison Brouckman placed fourth and Leanne Hyer secured fifth. The girls 9 year old event was all about the Fintastics: Allison Pinegar took first, Katherine Leeds, second, Kimberly Blauer, third, Sally Wade, fourth and Katharine Lucas, fifth. Melissa Jarmas came in second in the girls 10 level, with a time of 45:14. Fintastics, Ana Demson and Suzanne Huycke, turned in strong times to finish third and fifth, respectively, in the girls 11-12 freestyle. Backstroke

In the boys 7-8 year backstroke, **Steven Robbins** took third and **Patrick Cary** took fifth. The 9 and 10 year old boys event was won by **Edward Reed**, with fourth place in this event going to **Evan Hyer** and sixth to **Liam McLaughin**. FMW did well in the boys 11-12, taking second place (**Chris Kearns**) and fifth (**Jason Horneck**).

The 6 and under backstroke was a strong event for FMW girls. **Stephanie Hallock** secured first place, followed closely by **Chloe Siebach** in second, **Emily Wade** in fourth and **Sarah Wall** in fifth. **Kayley Byrne** recorded a time of 44:58 to place sixth in the girls 13-14 event and **Sarah Wallace** powered to a first place finish in the 15-18 heats.

Breaststroke

Dan Traxler and **Andy Putch** brought home second and fourth places, respectively, in the boys 7-8 event. **Edward Reed** stroked to a first place finish in the boys 9-10, followed by **Jack Brennan** taking third in the same event. **Jason Horneck** brought home fourth place in the 11-12 heats and **Mike Leeds** secured third in the 15-18 category.

Not to be outdone, the girls contributed a second place finish by **Megan McRoberts** in the girls 6

and unders. Caroline Beury took third and Leanne Hyer, fifth, in the competitive 7-8 category. Melissa Jarmas cruised to a first place finish and Katherine Leeds finished sixth in the 9-10 level. Melissa Duvall grabbed fifth place in the 11-12 breaststroke while, in the 13-14 event, Anna Clement took third and Annie Brennan, fourth. Rounding out the girls' effort, Grace Hyland took home fourth place honors in the 15-18 event.

Butterfly

The Fintastics boys came up with solid performances on the 'fly, placing second (**Bobby Demson**), third (**John Suyama**) and fourth (**William Happ**) in the 9-10 event. **Kevin Pujanauski** secured second place in the 11-12 level and **Matt Montgomery** did the same in the 13-14s. **Joey Coffinberger's** efforts meant a third place finish for him in the 15-18 event.

Allison Jarmas headed the pack to finish first with a time of 27:87 in the girls 8 and under 'fly. The Fintastics were strong in the 11-12 event, with Suzanne Huycke bringing home second and Melissa Duvall, third. Brigid Howland and Sarah Wallace placed second and third, respectively in the 15-18 event.

Individual Medley

Michael Hallock bested the field to take first place in the 9 and under IM. Edward Reed grabbed third place in the 10 year old event. Chris Kearns took fifth and Kevin Pujanauski took sixth in the 11-12 heats. Not to be outdone, Matt Montgomery brought home third and Zack Kearns, fifth, in the 13-14 event. Tommy Huycke powered to a first place finish in the boys 15-18 category.

The girls proved to be a force to be reckoned with, taking first (Alison Jarmas) and second (Leann Hyer) in the girls 9 and under. Erica Demson delivered a strong performance, taking second in the girls 10 year old IM. Kirsten Siebach finished second and Suzanne Huycke, third, in the 11-12 levels. Hannah Cohen secured second, Lindsay Ward, fifth, and Sascha Reed, sixth for the 13-14 years. Allison Kendrick gave a strong performance to finish second for the Fintastics in the 15-18 event.
