# <u>Fox Mill Woods Fintastics vs. Hiddenbrook -</u> July 14, 2001

In a tightly contested meet on Saturday, the Fox Mill Wood Fintastics prevailed over Hiddenbrook by a two-point margin to improve their season record to 3-1.

The Fintastics racked up points early in freestyle, with first place finishes in the boys 8 & under (**Andy Putch**), boys 9-10 (**Edward Reed**), 11-12 (**Scott Hubal**) and 15-18 (**Tommy Huycke**). **Leann Hyer** gave a boost to the team with her first place finish in the girls' 8 & under free.

Second place finishers in the freestyle included Andrew Gyenis, Matthew Montgomery,

Stephanie Hallock, Kirsten Siebach and Sascha Reed.

Grabbing more points for the Fintastics were freestyle third placers: Jennifer Dolson, Lindsay Ward, Ana Demson, and Liam McLaughlin.

In the backstroke events, the Hiddenbrook swimmers gave chase, but the Fintastics bagged top honors in four categories. First place finishers were **Andrew Gyenis**, **Michael Hallock**, **Leann Hyer** and **Kirsten Siebach**.

Second places were awarded to **Dan Traxler**, **Matthew Montgomery**, **Stephanie Hallock**, **Suzanne Huycke** and **Hannah Cohen**. Third place finishers (**Andy Putch**, **Bobby Demson**, **Christopher Kearns**, **Rob Burton**, **Allison Pinegar**, and **Kelly Sherman**) kept the score close.

Five first place finishes in the breastroke helped the Fintastics to keep Hiddenbrook at bay. Finishing first for FMW were Dan Traxler, Michael Hallock, Brian Pujanauski, Katie Callahan and Kirsten Siebach. Determined stroking brought second place honors to Liam McLaughlin, Ben Coffinberger, Rob Burton, Caroline Beury, Melissa Jarmas, Suzanne Huycke, Hannah Cohen and Jennifer Dolson. Touching in for third place points in the breaststroke were Michael Leeds, Alina Suyama and Katherine Leeds.

In the butterfly event, FMW swimmers Edward Reed and Scott Hubal took first place. Melissa Duvall, Kristen Callahan and Tommy Huycke came in second and Brigid Howland, Erica Demson, Brendan Lins and took third place in their age groups.

In the 8 and under 100 meter free relay, the boys team of **Putch**, **Robbins**, **Traxler and Gyenis** seized first place with a time of 1.38.84. Not to be outdone, the 8 & under girls (**Hallock**, **Brouckman**, **Jarmas and Hyer**) posted a

1.35.51 time enroute to their win in the 100 M free relay.

Other relay winners included the 9-10 boys team of **Demson**, **Hallock**, **McLaughlin and Reed**, and the 9-10 girls: **Demson**, **Callahan**, **Callahan and Jarmas**.

Winning the 11-12 girls relay for FMW was the **Huycke, Siebach, Duvall and Demson** squad. The girls 15-18 team of **Dolson, Howland, Callahan and Wallace** also prevailed with a time of 2:27.66.

The mixed age relay team of **Hubal**, **Hallock**, **Montgomery and Huycke** posted an "All Star" time of 2:09.12.

**Final score, Fox Mill Woods 202, Hiddenbrook, 200.** Results of this meet were featured in the Washington Post sports section under NVSL news.

Notable improvements this week: Twenty-seven new personal bests were recorded this week at the Hiddenbrook meet.
